One of the commitments they made is to “only submit for approval or emergency use authorization (EUA) after demonstrating safety and efficacy through a phase 3 clinical study that is designed and conducted to meet requirements of expert regulatory authorities such as FDA.”

None of the candidate vaccines in advanced clinical trials have so far demonstrated a "clear signal" of efficacy at the level of at least 50% sought by the WHO, spokeswoman Margaret Harris said last week.

Moderna and others vaccine cartel scammers

Finally, it looks like companies like Moderna and other pharmaceutical giants have realized they cannot continue to promote their company stock and receive billions of dollars in grants on a false scientific premise. Many of these CEO’s like Moderna’s Stéphane Bancel, have already enriched themselves quite a bit by hyping their phony vaccine claims and selling shares at an inflated price.
